Reunion Registration

The cost will be \$60 per cadet and \$40 per guest. Faculty members will receive a special rate of \$40 per faculty member and \$20 per guest. While we encourage immediate registration, please be aware that a minimum \$20 deposit will be due by August 30th, with the balance due September 16th. Late registrations will be accepted for an additional \$15 between August 31st and September 16th. The registration fee gets you into all reunion events and each cadet receives a great Welcome Packet.

We encourage your early registration for several reasons. Avoid the rush, and the advance money gives us the operating funds we so desperately need. So, if you can, why not just get it out of the way and pay in full right now?
