In early April, we had located approximately 200 former cadets. Since that date, we have almost tripled the number! Our first directory will go to press with almost 600 entries!

But the efforts were so worthwhile.

Entries will be listed alphabetically with the data sheet bios included; by Class (Graduation) Year; by Geographical Location (City and State); and a special e-mail section for those of you techy types. The book will be coil bound for ease of use, and will include some appropriate artwork and photos.
